# GENERAL RULES INFORMATION

**Entry Deadline: February 18, 2012**

## **GENERAL RULES - SHOW**

1. Shavings can be used, however they will NOT be available for sale.
2. Entries are unlimited. There will be no refunds on entry fees. Late fee for Entries is \$25/entry.
3. CPPA reserves the right to refuse any entry.
4. Breeding and Club Pigs must be checked in and in place on Friday, March 9 at 7:00PM. Jackpot Pigs must be checked in and in place, Sunday, March 11 by 7:00AM. If exhibitor is late, a charge of \$50/hour will be charged and may not be able to show.
5. All out of state Breeding animals require a certificate of veterinary inspection and a health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian. Health documents must accompany each animal in transport.
6. All exhibitors at the 2012 California Pork Spectacular must be a CPPA member.
7. All swine entered in the Pork Spectacular MUST have a premise ID. To obtain your premise ID, contact your state Department of Agriculture.

## **GENERAL RULES - SALE**

1. CPPA will not bill individuals for purchased swine. Animals purchased on sale day through the sale must be paid for on sale date. Only exhibitors who have sold animals in the sale will be allowed the opportunity to be billed.
2. Checks for payment from individuals or firms that have had check(s) returned to CPPA due to non-sufficient funds in the past will not be accepted at the 2012 Pork Spectacular. Cash, check, money order or cashiers check will be the only form of payment accepted.
3. Sale order and number sold will be determined by the judge and Swine Improvement Committee.
4. Animals sold in accordance with Swine Code of Fair Practices.
5. A commission of 15% to CPPA and the NPB check off will be retained on animals sold.
6. Animals purchased in the sale can be taken from the grounds immediately following the sale, and must be off the grounds at the conclusion of the Jackpot Show.
7. All breeding swine entered in the show and selected for the sale must go through the auction. If an entry in the BREEDING SHOW ONLY does not make the sale, the exhibitor may pay an extra \$25 fee to consign it to auction. Entries in the club pig sift not selected for the sale may not be consigned to auction.

## **PUREBRED BREEDING SWINE SHOW**

1. Age Requirements: Open Gilts - Farrowed on or after August 1, 2011  
Boars - Farrowed on or after August 1, 2011  
Bred Gilts – Farrowed April 1 to July 31, 2011 (must show evidence of being bred and have passed over)
2. Must meet breed eligibility requirements of their respective Breed Registries.
3. All entries must be registered with original papers submitted at check-in. Bred gilts must have breeding certificate attached to registration paper. (No copies of pedigrees will be accepted.) Pigs must be registered in the name of the CPPA member in order to be eligible to show.
4. Bred Gilts must be purebred; may carry a crossbred litter and bred.

# **GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION**

**Entry Deadline: February 18, 2012**

## **CROSSBRED BREEDING SWINE SHOW**

1. Age Requirements: Open Gilts - Farrowed on or after August 1, 2011  
Boars - Farrowed on or after August 1, 2011  
Bred Gilts – Farrowed April 1 to July 31, 2011(must show evidence of being bred and have passed over)
2. Classes will be broken by weight.

## **CLUB PIG SIFT AND SALE**

1. Recommended farrowing date range for project pigs is Dec. 15 and after (any age for prospective club pigs will qualify for this sale).
2. All purebred weanling pigs that show in the purebred class must have a pedigree that accompanies each entry or they will show as a crossbred.
3. All pigs must be ear notched.
4. Barrows, boars or gilts are eligible. Barrows and boars may be exhibited in separate classes, depending on the number of entries. Gilts will be shown in separate classes.
5. A minimum of 50 percent of the pigs shown per breed will be selected for the sale.
6. Sale commission will be 15 percent.

## **JUNIOR JACKPOT SHOW**

1. Accepted weight range: max of 280 lbs. Official Weigh in will take place from 7:00 am – 9:00 am on March 11.
2. All Jackpot Pigs must be in place by March 11 at 7am.
3. There is no limit on the number of entries.
4. Animals exhibited in either the Breeding swine show or the club pig sift that meet the weight requirements for the jackpot and are purchased by a junior member through the sale may be entered into the jackpot show. The late fee will be waived for these entries
5. Awards will be made as follows:
  - Supreme Champion Jackpot Hog: \$750 and Buckle
  - Reserve Supreme Champion Jackpot Hog: \$500
- Class Premiums: 1st \$50, 2nd \$40, 3rd \$30, 4th \$20
6. This is NOT a terminal show.

## **ENTRY FEES:**

Jackpot \$35/head  
Breeding Swine Show \$35/head  
Late fee: \$50/head  
Entry Deadline – February 18, 2012
